This privacy policy outlines how the NH Center for Nonprofits uses and protects any information given to the Center by anyone using this website, attending events, or otherwise engaging with the Center.

The Center's goals in enacting this policy is protecting your information and ensuring that your information is used appropriately.

While the purpose of this policy will remain the same, the specifics therein are subject to change. We ask that you check this page occasionally to ensure that you are both aware and comfortable with any changes.

This policy is effective from December 1st, 2010.

WHAT INFORMATION ARE YOU COLLECTING ABOUT ME?

The Center collects the following information:

- name, title and organizational affiliations
- · contact information including email address
- demographic information, i.e. postal code, preferences and interests

What do you use my information for?

The information we collect may be used to:

- maintain our records, the bulk of which are focused on event attendance, membership, and payment
- improve the resources and services we offer, e.g. our website, workshops, etc.
- contact you about resources or services we think you'll find interesting

We will never distribute, sell, or lease your information to any third-parties unless we have your express permission or are required by law.

HOW DO YOU KEEP MY INFORMATION SECURE?

The Center prevents unauthorized access to or unintended disclosure of your information using both physical and electronic protection, coupled with comprehensive managerial procedures.

How can I control my information?
